

Working With Campers

Band Coach

Some music experience is helpful

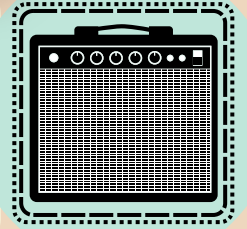
The campers form their bands on the first day of camp—that's when your work begins! As a Band Coach, you will provide guidance in all aspects of working as a collaborative creative time. This role involves helping your band set up and tune instruments, write songs, learn how to play together, figure out stage moves, etc.



Band Manager (Camp Counselor)

No music experience is necessary

As a Camp Counselor, you will serve as a mentor for an assigned group of campers. Counselors must be available during camp week, Monday-Friday, 8:45am-6pm. No music experience is necessary. This role involves participating in games and skits, making sure campers are where they need to be at all times, accompanying campers between classrooms, offering advice and help throughout the day, etc.



Instrument Instructor

Music experience is necessary

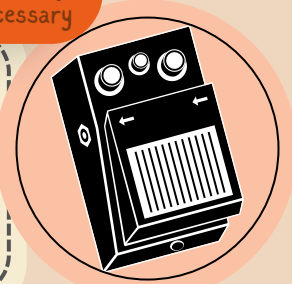
As an Instrument Instructor, you will teach campers how to play one of the following musical instruments: electric guitar, electric bass, drums, keyboard, or vocals. Instructors must be available during camp week, Monday-Friday, 9am-12pm. Music experience is necessary. This role involves planning lessons with other instructors, teaching campers the basics of a new instrument, creating a supportive learning environment for campers, etc.



Workshop Facilitator

No music experience is necessary

As a workshop facilitator, you will provide a one-hour lesson to campers on a topic relevant to the GRC mission in which you have experience. Workshop facilitators must be available to teach 1 or 2 one-hour sessions on their scheduled day, submit a workshop proposal in addition to a volunteer application, and meet with a Camp Organizer to discuss curriculum before camp. This role involves developing learning plans, presenting the workshop to groups of campers organized by age, co- and/or team-teaching during the workshop, etc.



Posi Posse

No music experience is necessary

We all need a little extra positivity sometimes! The Posi Posse will make and hang artwork, get campers hyped during assemblies, and keep the energy going during down time! All Camp Volunteers are expected to support the Posi Posse as able during camp.



Licensed Clinical Counselor

No music experience is necessary

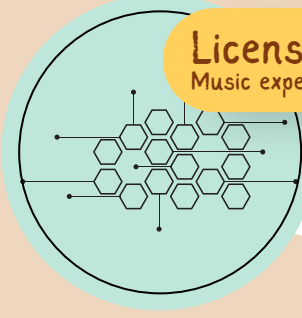
On the occasion that a personal issue arises for campers, you will be available to talk with them and/or refer them to services if needed. This role has a flexible schedule.



Licensed Nurse

Music experience is necessary

A licensed nurse is needed on-site all week. You will provide health care services to campers if needed. This role has a flexible schedule.

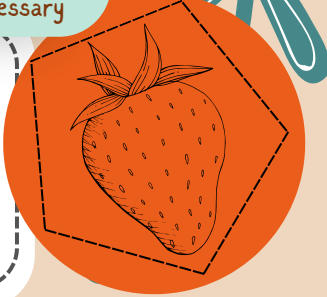


Behind the Scenes

Food Crew

No music experience is necessary

Snacks are provided twice daily for campers to enjoy and the GRC Food Crew helps cook and prepare lunch on-site during camp week. This role will involve picking up food donations, going on supply runs, preparing food as needed, etc. This role has a flexible schedule and might require a ServSafe certification.



Gear Crew

Some music experience is helpful

All musicians rely on their amazing roadies! Help us set up, break down and move instruments, amps, PAs, workshop supplies, etc., throughout the week. This role has a flexible schedule.



Door Crew

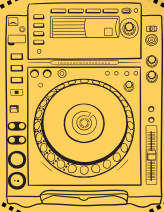
No music experience is necessary

You're making sure that folks going "backstage" are on the list! This role assists with the daily camper check-in and check-out. As a Front Desk Volunteer, you will also monitor visitors, coordinate in-camp communication, provide directions, answer questions, and (possibly) sell showcase tickets. This role has a flexible schedule.



Stage Manager

Music experience is necessary



You're a go-to! This role helps with last-minute and short-notice needs, i.e. running to make copies or the hardware store, filling in if another volunteer can't make their shift, supporting instrument instructors, band coaches, band managers, workshop facilitators, etc., and helping out as situations arise. This role has a flexible schedule.

Showcase Support

No music experience is necessary

We need hands on deck to sell tickets and merch, fold programs, and help ensure that all aspects of the showcase concert run smoothly. Must be available on the Saturday of camp week.
